



Exhibit Specifications for “Faster, Higher, Stronger: Michigan Women in Olympic History”

Opening Banner:

- 1 Vinyl banner measuring 7' H x 4' W

Text/Photo Panels:

- 2 Panels highlighting Michigan's five most decorated female Olympians: 3' H x 3' W
- 3 Panels honoring the two Olympians in the Michigan Women's Hall of Fame, the effect of Title IX on women's participation in sports, and women at the ancient Olympics: 3' H x 4' W
- 5 Panels describing female Olympians who were born in Michigan, were Michigan college competitors, or trained with Michigan coaches: 3' H x 3' W
- 2 Charts marking women's participation at each Olympics as well as the years each woman's sport was introduced: 18" H x 4' W
- 1 Michigan map noting hometowns of female Olympians: 4' H x 4' W
- 1 Table corresponding to map: 4' H x 2' W
- 1 Donor panel: 4' H x 2' W
- 1 Podium
- 1 Photo panel of a crowd background: 54" H x 83" W

- 21 Panels: 4" H x 8" W

Notes:

1) The exhibit, which occupies 90 linear feet of space, may be rented for a fee of **\$100 per week for a minimum of four weeks.**

2) All panels are for INDOOR USE ONLY.

3) All panels can be hung by Velcro on a fabric surface or by nail on plastered walls or placed on easels. Each banner is equipped with plastic hanging tabs.

4) The exhibit travels in 2 cases: the opening banner is stored in a tube box, measuring 56" x 7" x 7.5"; the text/photo banners are stored in one huge case with wheels, measuring 66" x 51.5" x 9" (this case is extremely large and requires at least 2 people to move it). The exhibit must be picked up from and delivered back to the Michigan Women's Historical Center by minivan or covered pick-up truck at the renter's cost.

5) To supplement the exhibit, the renter might want to consider purchasing books on the subject which include "Women in Olympic Sports," a children's activity book produced by Griffin Publishing Group, and "Grace and Glory: A Century of Women in the Olympics" produced by Triumph book.
